



## DO YOU SEE YOURSELF?

Learning Objective: The Students will...

Identify examples of good citizenship and community involvement

Materials Needed:

- Large Civic Works! poster
- Individual maps for students (Ledger size 11 x 17)

Vocabulary: Community service, citizenship

Teaching Strategy:

1. To introduce the Civic Works! map, share the large map with the class and ask them the following questions.
  - What do you see happening on this map?
  - What are people doing?
  - What buildings are on the map? Have students use the map coordinates and state the purpose of each building. (Note: Have them look in the windows)
2. Divide students into groups of 3-5 and give each student an individual map. Explain to students that they should circle examples of people serving their community.
3. Have each group report what they have discovered and give the coordinates of each. Teacher will record for the whole class to see.
4. Ask students if they have participated in similar acts of community service. Allow students to share their experiences.
5. Ask students to draw themselves at a location on the map where they would like to be helping their community and tell why they have chosen this place.
